- 5. The local park was successful managing the flood mitigation but what contamination, sewerage, chemicals, poisons etc have now contaminated our local soils? Is it time to stop using our local parkland as a flood mitigation until we do not know where this water has come from and what is in it?
- 6. Improving and upgrading infrastructure such as local drainage systems and levees to better manage and redirect floodwaters and to implement effective flood prevention measures.
