The bluestone embankment on the east side of Farnsworth Avenue bridge on the Moonee Valley side is overgrown, a pedestrian safety issue and the weeds and bushes are now enormous and gradually damaging the embankment. The bridge and embankment are a choke point on the river. In flood they restrict flow and overgrown bushes can catch and retain debris further exacerbating their impact.

Demarcation issues between Melbourne Water and Council and ? may be a contributing factor and if so should be eliminated.

Additional flood flow area could also be provided under the bridge approaches on the west bank to facilitate higher water flow at low levels of flooding.

Similarly building a playground on the floodplain opposite the Flemington Racecourse flood wall only further restricts the available flood flow particularly after floating debris inevitably becomes ensuared in the facilities.

All these small impacts manifest themselves further upstream at Raleigh Rd and beyond.
