# **Maribyrnong River Flood Review**

Community Bulletin – February 2023



- The review into the Maribyrnong River flood event has begun
- Participate in the Review: Make a submission, share your experience or attend a community information session

Melbourne Water has set up an independent review of the Maribyrnong River flood event that occurred on the 14th of October, 2022.

The review will focus on the urban catchment of the Maribyrnong River (the part of the river within Greater Melbourne) and consider:

- the causes and contributors to the Flood Event in the urban catchment, including any potential impacts of the Flemington Racecourse Flood Wall on the extent and duration of the Flood Event;
- any impact of prior works or activities in the urban catchment on flood levels and extent during the Flood Event; and
- whether any other matters may have significantly contributed to the Flood Event.

Melbourne Water is committed to an independent and transparent review process and the Maribyrnong River Flood Review will be undertaken by an Independent Review Panel that will be appointed in the coming weeks.

## How to participate

#### 1. Make a submission

You can contribute to the Maribyrnong River Flood Review by providing information that will will help the independent Review Panel understand the possible causes and contributors to the flood event.

Anybody can make a submission and you can do so via email, post, or through an online submission form.

Submissions are open now and will close on the 17 March 2023.

#### 2. Share your experience

If you have a personal experience you would like to share about the flood, you can do so online or in person.

#### 3. Attend a community information session

Melbourne Water is hosting a series of in-person and online community information sessions.

These sessions are an opportunity to learn more about the review and submission process, ask questions and share your experience of the Maribyrnong river flood event.

Representatives from Melbourne Water, and other agencies will be in attendance to answer your questions.
